
The Best Hotels In Singapore's Chinatown Area



The property boasts 324 rooms across three distinct room categories—Grand Premier, Premier and Deluxe rooms. Signature to the hotel are the MASTER Series rooms (made up of 18 Grand Premier and 60 Premier Rooms) which offer highly customised touchpoints catered to the discerning traveller. Designed to inspire a sense of belonging, the MASTER Series guest experience starts even before your arrival at the hotel, with personalised services like airport check-in, luggage forwarding and luxury airport transfers.

There's also a fully equipped gym with modern equipment, complete with Fitness-on-Demand personal training, as well as a traditional Wing Chun wooden dummy for a well-rounded workout. The Sky Pool on level 30 offers a bird's eye view of the surrounding heritage district along with semi-submerged lounge chairs for the ultimate in relaxation. Taking up two levels within The Clan Hotel, QĪN Restaurant & Bar by TungLok Group is open daily and offers up creative renditions of Asian classics.
